

## CP1000 SOFTWARE CHANGE

Before you can change the software on a CP1000 you first need to prepare a laptop and have a USB to MiniUSB cable to transfer the software.

### STEP 1

Download the Bury Update Manager and run the file.

This will create a new directory on the laptop:

C:/Program Files/BuryUpdateManager

### STEP 2

Download from the above link and save the V239 Software and the Driver files to the newly created directory. Do NOT open the files.

### STEP 3

Turn on the CP1000. Cancel out the Sim message if no SIM is installed.

Navigate through the menu to the Software update section:

SETTINGS >> PHONE >> SYSTEM >> SOFTWARE UPDATE >> YES

Plug in the Mini USB cable into the handset. In the "DEVICES and PRINTERS" section of your computer you should see the CP1000 appear as a box like icon and be named "Carphone". Some older or cheaper USB cables may not show the carphone. If doing this for the first time the laptop probably will not have a driver installed for it so by right clicking on the icon and you can update the driver for this device (browse to the driver file that you saved earlier).

Once you have the driver and device set up the properties/hardware tab will show you what COM port your computer has allocated to this device.

### STEP 4

Run the Bury Update Manager. Follow the "NEXT" prompts and then browse to find the software you downloaded earlier.

Select the COM port and keep clicking "NEXT" until the process is complete.

Once your driver is installed the whole process should only take a minute or so to complete.
